Goals

- Provide more prescriptive advice where possible
 - Include second, or even, third best options
- Incorporate advances in methods/practice as well as theory/research

Goals

- ► Recognize global outreach
 - Developed and developing countries
- Provide practical and theoretical advice to compilers
- Serve as a valuable resource for data users

Progress so far

- Work began in January with plan of chapters and designation of authors
- Annotated outlines already produced
- Drafting is underway on chapters

June – July 2015	Establishment of the TEG-CPI, including chair and editor
January 2016	TEG-CPI to develop proposal for detailed time plan, allocation of work of authors, quality assurance and draft outline of the updated manual, which includes a complete list of the proposed chapters and annexes of the update. A face-to-face meeting of the TEG-CPI organised.
May 2016	Presentation of the outline of the updated manual, including a list of main changes chapter-by-chapter to the meeting of the UNECE-ILO CPI Group of Experts Meeting, May 2016.
June – December 2016	Reviewing and drafting of outline of chapters. Communication by audio conferences/e-mails.
January 2017	Face to Face meeting of TEG-CPI to finalize chapter outlines.
April 2017	Final chapter outlines submitted to IWGPS.
February 2017 – December 2017	Drafting of first version of the chapters. Draft chapters to be submitted to the IWGPS on a rolling basis as available.
August 2017 – December 2017	Draft chapters to be posted on secure website for worldwide review on a rolling basis as available.
May 2017	Presentation of progress and broad overview of changes to the meeting of the Ottawa Group, May 9-12, 2017
October 2017 – January 2018	Revising draft chapters, taking comments from countries into account. Chapters revised on a rolling basis.
January 2018	Submission of final draft to the IWGPS for approval
February – May 2018	Final editing and approval of the IWGPS
June - September 2018	Formal consultation of countries.
February - March 2019	Submission of the final manual for endorsement by the UNSC in February 2019 [to be confirmed]
Reporting to IWGPS	Chair and Editor to submit progress report to IWGPS on quarterly basis beginning June 2017. Reports to be sent by last week of each quarter.

 - Made available chapter-by-chapter
- Designated reviewers for each chapter
- TEG members to review; wider CPI community invited to review

- Regional seminars on updated manual
